Dear Wesleyan Academy Community:

As we approach the end of this blessed school year, I would like to share the following items for your attention:

- The school's only authorized supplier of uniforms is [Olimac Uniforms](#), at #218 Ave. Laurel, Minillas Industrial Park, Bayamón. Olimac Uniforms business hours are currently Monday-Friday 8:00 am - 5:00 pm, Saturday 10:00 am - 2:00 pm. Closed on Sundays. 787- 787-2830
- Physical Education uniforms and the official school jacket will be sold ONLY at the Eagle Store.
- Note to 11th and 12th-grade parents: PE is not a part of the 11th and 12th-grade curriculum; therefore, you do not have to purchase the PE uniform for your 11th and 12th grade students.
- Please note that the **uniform transition year has concluded**. Beginning in the 2026–2027 school year, students in grades 1–12 must wear the new uniform: a navy blue polo with the embroidered school insignia along with the appropriate khaki skort (for girls), bermuda shorts, or dress pants with the school insignia. In addition, the school will strictly enforce the established uniform policy stating that all khaki skorts with the school insignia must be no more than three (3) inches above the knee. Olimac Uniforms, our authorized uniform supplier, carries the approved-length skorts. Families are encouraged to request assistance at the store if needed, as their staff is aware of this requirement.
- Parent cooperation in following the uniform policy is requested as it will be strictly enforced.

# SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY SUMMARY

The Dean of Student Affairs requests your cooperation in abiding by these rules so that your children and our school look their very best. Students should always wear the appropriate and complete uniform while in school.

1. **REGULAR SCHOOL UNIFORM** (available at [Olimac Uniforms](#), #218 Ave. Laurel Minillas Industrial Park, Bayamón, 00959 ☎ 787-787-2830 - close to COSTCO in Bayamón) [Uniform Price List 2026-2027](#)

## Pre Pre-Kinder and Pre-Kinder

- Boys: Khaki shorts with royal blue polo with embroidered school insignia
- Knee-length Bermuda shorts, dress pants, or khaki skirt with school insignia; skirts may not be more than three (3) inches above the knee.
- Tennis shoes may be of any color as long as they do not have logos or designs that oppose our school's teachings. For example, violence-inciting characters or poor character role models
- White or black crew-length socks (up to the calf)



## Kinder to Eleventh Grade

Girls:

- Navy blue polo with embroidered school insignia
- Knee-length Bermuda shorts, dress pants, or khaki skirt with school insignia; skirts may not be more than three (3) inches above the knee.
- Solid black footwear, including the sole
- White or black crew-length socks (up to the calf)

Boys:

- Navy blue polo with embroidered school insignia
- Khaki bermuda, or dress pants with school insignia
- Solid black footwear, including the sole
- White or black crew-length socks (up to the calf)



### **Twelfth Grade (Monday-Thursday)**

Girls:

- Polo or Button Down Collar (color and logo as selected by the Senior Class and approved by the High School Principal)
- Khaki skort (no more than three inches above the knee), bermuda, or dress pants with school insignia
- Solid black footwear, including the sole
- White or black crew-length socks (up to the calf)

Boys:

- Polo or Button Down Collar (color and logo as selected by the Senior Class and approved by the High School Principal)
  - Khaki bermuda, or dress pants with school insignia
  - Solid black footwear, including the sole
  - White or black crew-length socks (up to the calf)

### **Twelfth Grade (Fridays)**

Mandatory Requirement – Wesleyan Academy Friday shirt as selected by the Senior class and approved by the High School Principal, with blue jeans.

## **2. PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM (available at the Wesleyan Academy Eagle Store)**

### **Pre Pre-Kinder and Pre-Kinder**

Will use their regular uniform for their physical education classes.

### **Kinder to Tenth Grade**

- Wesleyan Academy P.E. shirt
- Wesleyan Academy long gym sweatpants
- Tennis shoes of any color
- Students will come to school wearing the P.E. uniform on P.E. days.

## **3. ALL STUDENTS**

- Important: All khaki skorts with the school insignia must be no more than three (3) inches above the knee. Olimac Uniforms, our authorized uniform supplier, carries the approved-length skorts. Please ask for assistance at the store if needed, as their staff is aware of this requirement.
- Fridays (Grades PPK-11) - Wesleyan Academy approved t-shirts ONLY may be worn on Fridays with corresponding uniform (khaki pants, bermuda, or skort).
- Only the Wesleyan Academy uniform jacket may be worn over the regular shirt during cool weather. The uniform jacket may be purchased at the Eagle Store.
- Seniors may use any color sweater or jacket that is open in the front and without a hood.
- Roller tennis shoes (Heelys) may never be worn on school campus.
- Hats, sunglasses, bandannas, and scarves are not to be worn during the school day.
- No piece of the uniform may ever be worn to school if faded, stained, written on, torn or worn in appearance.
- Jackets, T-shirts, or other clothing with questionable advertising, i.e. alcoholic beverages or words, may not be worn in school, including for practices of teams or at school functions on or outside campus.
- Only girls may wear earrings, one per ear, and they may not hang below the ear lobe. Necklaces must be short and of discreet width, tucked inside the shirt collar. A maximum of two bracelets may be worn on each wrist, not counting the wristwatch.

- WA uniforms, student nametags, and key cards must be worn at all times during regular school days.
- WA uniforms and student nametags must be worn during field trips. Exceptions may be made upon approval by the Principal.
- Students may only use natural-looking hair color (brown, black, blond, red) and of a uniform appearance.
- Students may not wear visible body piercing or tattoos.

### **Blue Jean Days**

Jean Days are scheduled throughout the year for two purposes: (1) to allow students a break from the regular uniform and (2) as a fundraising opportunity. Each student will be required to pay a contribution of \$1.00. Jean Day attire consists of blue jeans (unfaded, without holes or rips) and a WA-approved t-shirt (e.g., field day, Puerto Rican Day, etc.). The same guidelines for *Dress Days* must be followed.

### **Dress Days**

Students may be allowed an occasional "dress day." Appropriate attire on dress day is as follows:

- modest clothing, not tight (no "skinny" jeans, no leggings), not see-through, etc.
- blouses, shirts (no crop tops), or dresses with sleeves (not see-through)
- skirts, bermuda-length shorts, or pants
- clothing that is not written on, faded, ripped, sloppy, or worn in appearance
- no inappropriate logos or designs that contradict the school's philosophy or values
- no hoodies, or Crocs
